<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A diploma from an accredited or state approved high school or its equivalent; • A minimum GPA of 2.0 in all high school coursework; • Proof of English proficiency (international students only). • A minimum GPA of 2.0 in all transferable coursework. 			
Degree Requirements			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Total Semester Hours: Undergraduate students are required to earn a minimum of 120 semester hours to be eligible to graduate from Trident University International. Some programs may require more units. • Residency: Students must complete a minimum of 30 semester hours at Trident University International. • Upper Division Course Requirement: Students must complete a minimum of 36 semester hours of coursework at the 300 and 400 levels. • General Education Program: Students must complete the General Education Program requirements as stated in the catalog. • Academic Program: Students must also satisfy all requirements of the individual program. • Minimum Grade: Students must receive a minimum grade of "D" in undergraduate coursework taken at Trident. • Capstone Grade: Students must receive a minimum grade of "C" in the undergraduate program capstone course. • Grade Point Average Requirement: Students must receive a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 in all undergraduate coursework taken at Trident.
