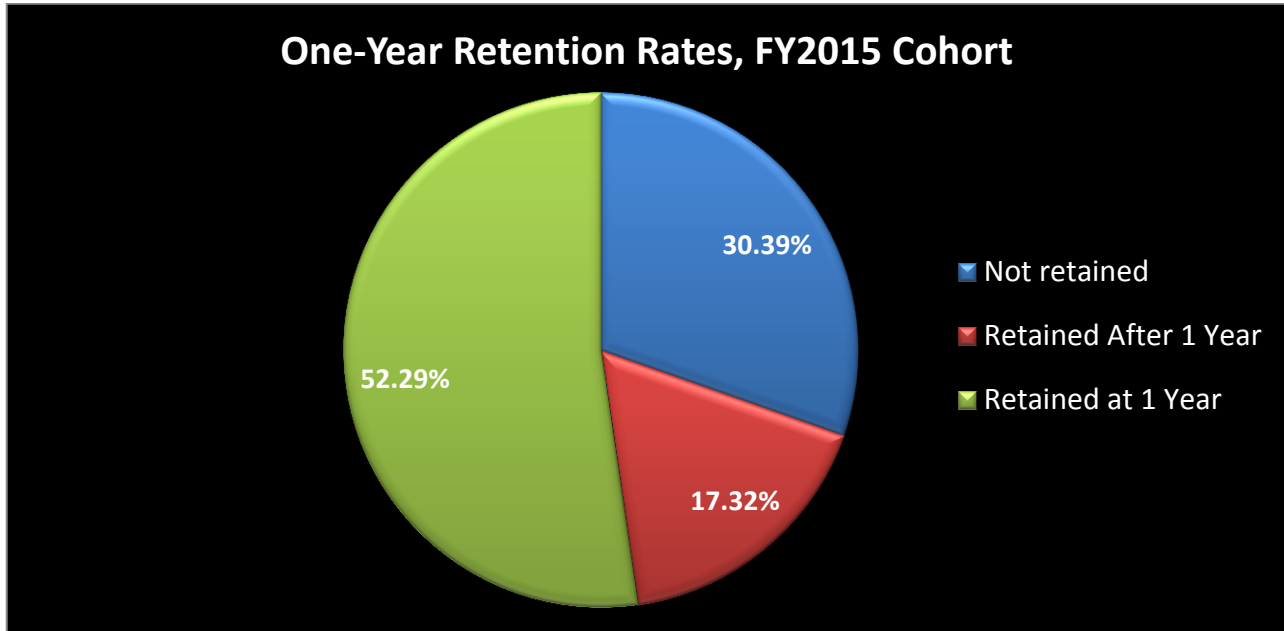

Definitions

Retention rate – Percent of entering cohort who enrolled one year later (within 3 month) or successfully completed their program. For example, students starting in January 2015 would be considered retained if they were enrolled in a term which started in either January, February, or March 2016.

Entering Cohort – Students who started a Bachelor's degree program for the first time at Trident University
