Admission Requirements			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A diploma from an accredited or state approved high school, or its equivalent. • Proof of English proficiency (international students only). • A certificate or diploma with at least 15 semester hours of transferable college credit, or equivalent military training, as defined by Trident's transfer policy • A minimum GPA of 2.0 in all transferable coursework or high school coursework (if less than 24 SH of post-secondary education) 			
Degree Requirements			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Total Semester Hours: Associate level students are required to earn a minimum of 60 semester hours to be eligible to graduate from Trident University International. Some programs may require more units. • Residency: Students must complete a minimum of 15 semester hours at Trident University International. • General Education Program: Students must complete the General Education Program requirements as stated in the catalog. • Academic Program: Students must also satisfy all requirements of the individual program. • Minimum Grade: Students must receive a minimum grade of "D" in undergraduate coursework taken at Trident. • Capstone Grade: Students must receive a minimum grade of "C" in the undergraduate program capstone course. • Grade Point Average Requirement: Students must receive a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 in all undergraduate coursework taken at Trident. 			
Transfer Policy			
Credits are considered for transfer from any regionally or nationally accredited college or university as well as The American Council on Education (ACE), College Level Examination Program (CLEP), The DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSST/DANTES), The Council for Adult and Experiential Learning (CAEL), and Excelsior, and other non-traditional forms of learning as deemed appropriate by College Deans or designees.
