Trident's Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership (Ed.D. EL) is intended for education professionals, in both traditional and non-traditional settings, who aspire to lead complex learning organizations. Learning in an all-online environment, students engage with faculty members on significant issues of policy and practice and benefit from opportunities to interact with peers from a wide variety of professional backgrounds. Concentration: *Higher Education Leadership*

The Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership with a Higher Education concentration is intended for students currently holding leadership positions or aspiring to obtain a leadership position in a postsecondary education setting as academic program administrators, campus administrators, and student affairs or student services professionals.

Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership

Concentration: *Instructional Design*

The Doctoral of Education in Educational Leadership with an Instructional Design in Education concentration is a practitioner-oriented program intended for students currently holding leadership positions or aspiring to obtain a leadership position in a military or civilian training program as an instructional systems specialist or instructional designer.



Instructional Design Concentration Courses

The Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership with a PK-12 leadership concentration is intended for students currently holding leadership positions or aspiring to obtain a leadership position in elementary and secondary education settings as educator-leaders, principals, vice principals, superintendents, and other administrative leaders.



PK-12 Leadership Concentration Core Courses

Designed to cover topics within the concentration. Two concentration courses are required, and one is selected by the student.

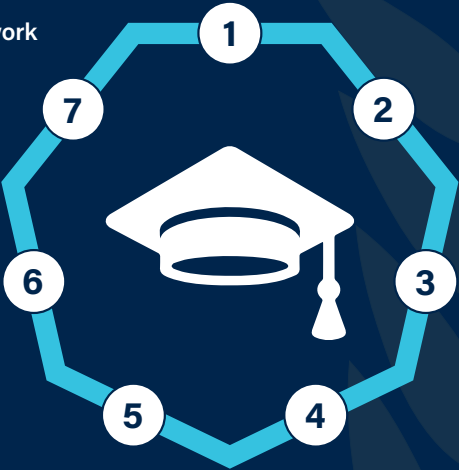
